MORROW, E. FREDERIC: Papers, 1952-63  
(Accessions A69-21 and A69-33)

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The Papers of E. Frederic Morrow are comprised of two small series, received as separate accessions in 1969. Accession 69-33 contains letters, memoranda, telegrams, newspapers, clippings, itineraries and speech drafts pertaining to Morrow's political activities on behalf of Eisenhower, particularly his activities on board the 1952 campaign train, as well as several items from the 1956 campaign. This accession also contains both official and personal correspondence from the period, 1955-1960 when Morrow served as Administrative Officer, Special Projects Group. These materials include congratulatory messages, thank-you notes, items relating to trips Morrow made on behalf of the Administration and to his administrative duties with the Special Projects Group.

The other accession, A69-21, contains a diary Morrow maintained intermittently from 1952 to 1960 (the bulk of the entries are dated 1955-1960), and drafts, galleys and related materials pertaining to the writing of Morrow's book, *Black Man in the White House*, published in 1963. The book was based largely on Morrow's experiences serving as head of the Special Projects Group, 1955-61. The diary is arranged chronologically, while the drafts and galleys are arranged by page number.
